This event will be a Non-Competitive Multi-Club Supersprint involving a Motorsport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall under and in accordance with the CASM MSPRA policy and the PCV developed processes and policy designed to assure that controls are in place to address all risk identified by PCV and MSPRA policy. The event will be passengers in cars only familiarisation event conducted at Sandown International Raceway over 3.1km in anti-clockwise direction.

15. Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

16. PASSENGERS

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.

(a) A briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.

(b) Passengers MUST:

i. wear the same protective gear as a Driver

ii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes

iii. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and Disclaimer

iv. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a Passenger.

v. Be at least 12 years of age

(c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.

(d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.

FURTHER REGULATIONS

CAMS Permit # 318/2511/06

Changes to Supplementary Regulations as follow:

Delete paragraph 16 and insert the following paragraphs:

16. Driver Behaviour

- The intent of the day is to showcase vehicles in a safe and enjoyable manner. All laps are to be limited to 80% of driver's capability at this track. Only a vehicle with a passenger will be permitted on the circuit. Maximum one passenger per vehicle.
- The Clerk of the Course may impose a penalty of up to exclusion from a session of the event any driver who:
 - In the opinion of the Clerk of Course drive in a manner inconsistent with the spirit of the event; or
 - Drives in a manner inconsistent with Track conditions; or
 - Drives with two (2) wheels off the defined track surface.
- The Clerk of Course may refer any competitor or driver to the Stewards of the Meeting, and recommend a penalty up to exclusion from the meeting, for any driver who:
 - Drives with four (4) wheels off the defined track surface;
 - Overtakes in a manner that causes the overtaken vehicle to deviate their line or take avoiding action; and/or
 - Overdrives as exhibited by getting their vehicle regularly out of shape, control or being involved in a spin.

17. Apparel

- Each competitor and passenger must wear neck to ankle to wrist non-flammable clothing in compliance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- Two helmets per vehicle must be presented at Scrutiny. Each helmet must carry a standard as listed in Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

18. Passengers

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy and the PCV developed processes.

(a) Each passenger must comply with the requirements for the event as set by PCV and in accordance with the policy and procedures for the activity as set by PCV and approved by CAMS.

(b) Passengers MUST:

- i. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes
- ii. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and Disclaimer
- iii. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a Passenger.
- iv. Be at least 12 years of age

(c) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.

(d) If a passenger cannot self-extricate from a vehicle, the track density will be limited to one vehicle whilst any passenger that requires assistance to extricate from a vehicle is on track.
