- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

Parade

The Event may, at the discretion of the Clerk of Course on the Day, include a Parade. The requirements for the Parade include:

- a) An official car will lead Parade vehicles at a moderate speed, and another official car will follow the Parade vehicles.
- b) The official car will be driven by an experienced driver.
- c) Unless a vehicle slows with an obvious problem, both overtaking and timing are prohibited.
- d) Such other requirements as the Clerk of Course in their discretion decide are appropriate on the day.

Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
