- Class eligibility and other requirements are in accordance with Porsche Club of Victoria Standing Competition Rules 2021

- The event will be a Multi-Club Super Sprint conducted at Sandown Raceway in an anti-clockwise direction
- The event will be held under and in accordance with the 2021 Porsche Club of Victoria Standing Competition Rules.
- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/ guardian.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

TESTING

- The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
- Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
